As such, each participant and the minors for which they are responsible for is requested to acknowledge the inherent risks for this Event by agreeing to the following terms of this agreement. The undersigned hereby releases and forever discharges Fellowship Bible Church and the Land-owner, its administrators, agents, assigns, and all other persons, firms, corporations and educational institutions, who it might be claimed to be liable, none of whom admit any liability from any and all claims, demands, actions, causes of action or suits of any kind or nature whatsoever and particularly on account of all injuries known and unknown, both to person and property, which have resulted or may in the future develop from any accident which might occur as a result of any participation in the Event.

The undersigned hereby declares that the terms of this settlement have been completely read and are fully understood and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full and final compromise adjustment and settlement of any and all claims, stipulated or otherwise, on account of the injuries and damages above mentions, and for the express purposes of precluding forever any further or additional claims arising out of any possibility accident by the undersigned.

It is further agreed that the release expresses a full and complete settlement of liability, regardless of the adequacy of the aforesaid and that the acceptance of this release shall not operate as an admission of the liability on the part of anyone, nor as estoppel, waiver or a bar with respect to any claim the part or parties release may have against the undersigned. This release is binding on any heirs, executors, assigns and administrators and is a voluntary release of any and all future injuries of accidents.

The undersigned and their dependants are aware of the risks of attending, traveling to and participating in the Event and hereby assumes all risks. The risks include those foreseen and unforeseen, known or unknown.
